- 3. Submit a signed acknowledgement of receipt of the Parent Handbook.
- 4. Payments will be electronically drafted the Friday before each week of care.
- 5. You will receive an email confirmation when your child's enrollment is confirmed.
- The Y accepts DHHS subsidy and childcare vouchers.
- Qualifying families may receive this program free of charge through 12/3 1/2 1 via the YMCA Alliance
