Tanglewood Field Trip



4th and 5th grade classes spent Monday at Tanglewood Camp in Lincolnville. The students used scientific observational skills to learn about the habits of birds in Maine. They created and shared “noise maps” to chart the bird sounds around them. They built loon nests using available materials. After lunch, the students played games designed to teach them about the dangers of bird migration. 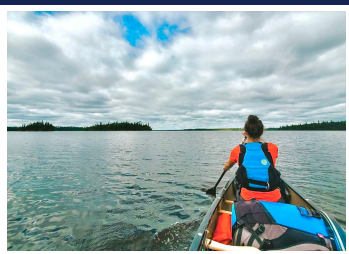

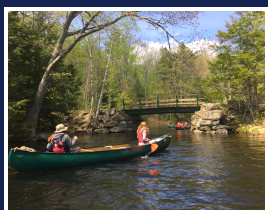
SEA KAYAKING WILDERNESS TRIP
