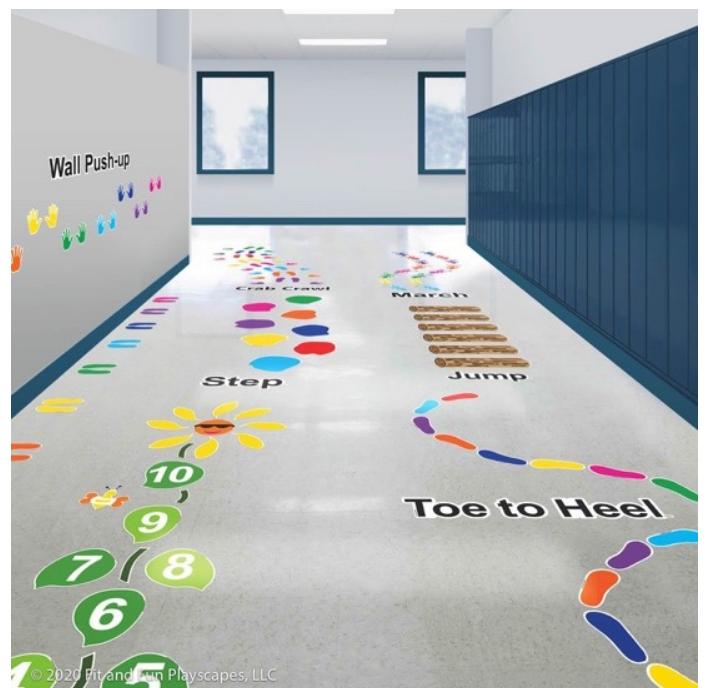

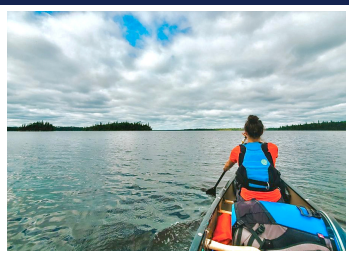

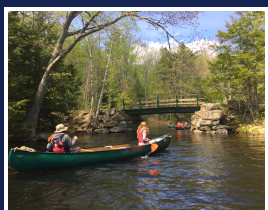
### SEA KAYAKING WILDERNESS TRIP
