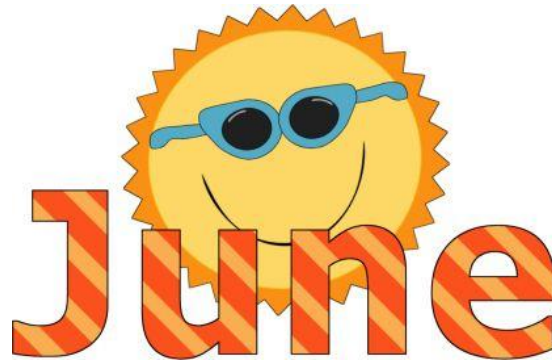

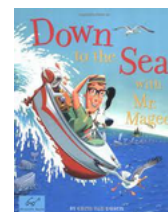


July 21st - Make your own - Ocean Crafts- Join Miss Amy for craft stations in the amphitheater.

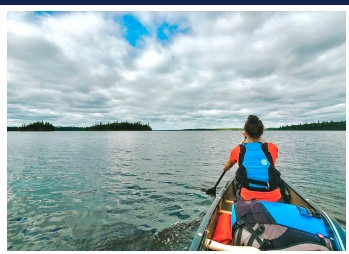

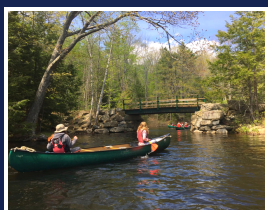
SEA KAYAKING WILDERNESS TRIP
