Just a quick reminder that we will be hosting a dental screening and fluoride clinic here at the school on September, 22.

Permission slips were sent home for you to sign and return. Please indicate if you do or do not want your child to participate in this program.

The American Academy of Pediatrics, American Dental Association and the United States Preventative Services Task Force recommend fluoride varnish treatments 2-4 times per year or every 3 - 6 months to help strengthen the teeth.

We will host the second clinic again in the spring.
