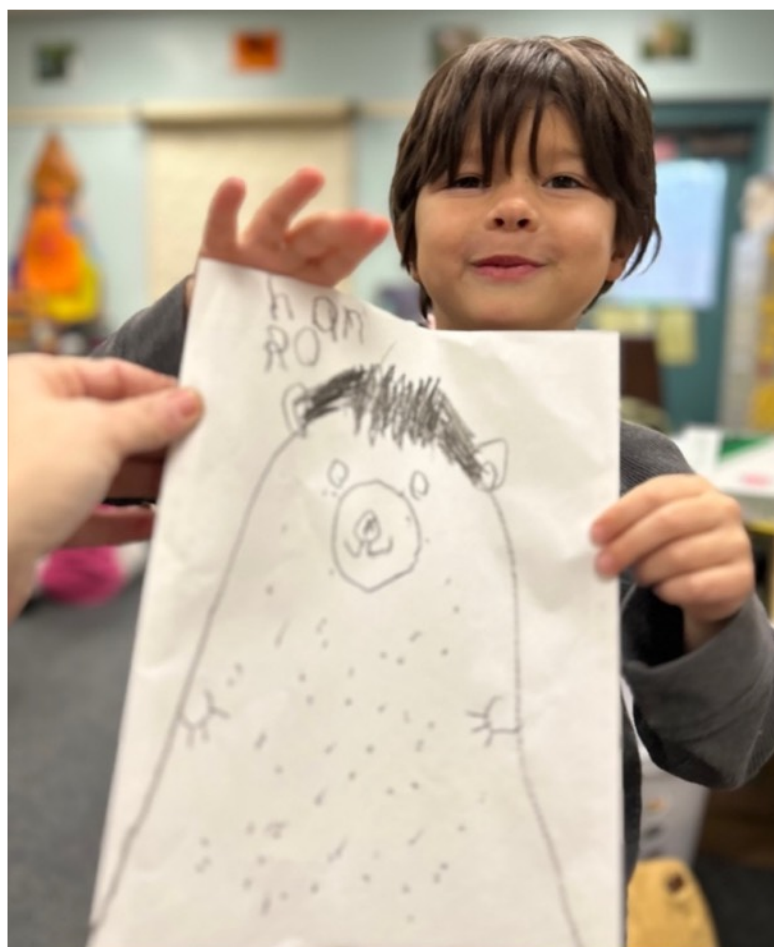
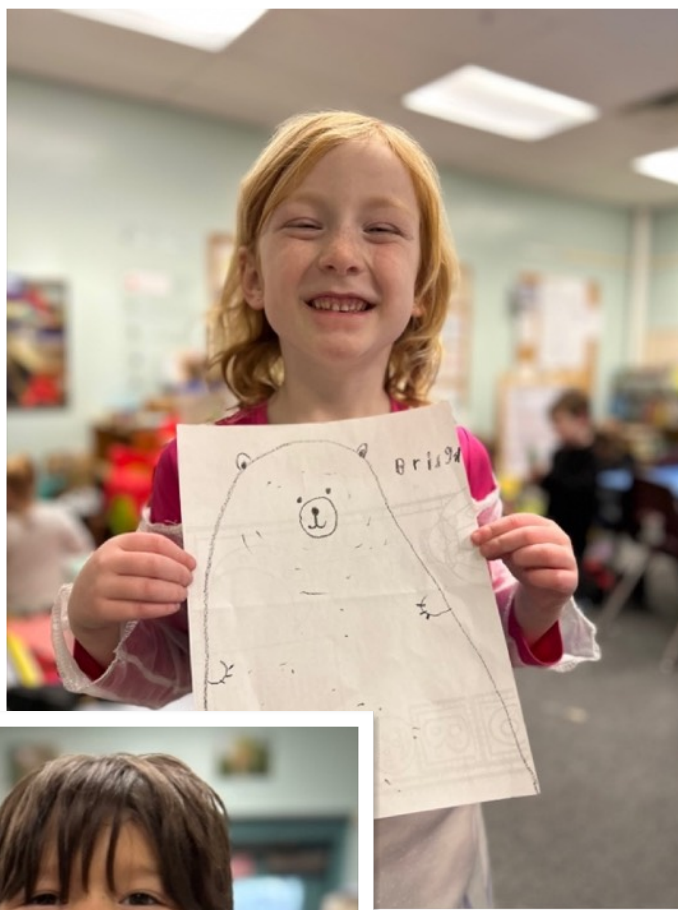
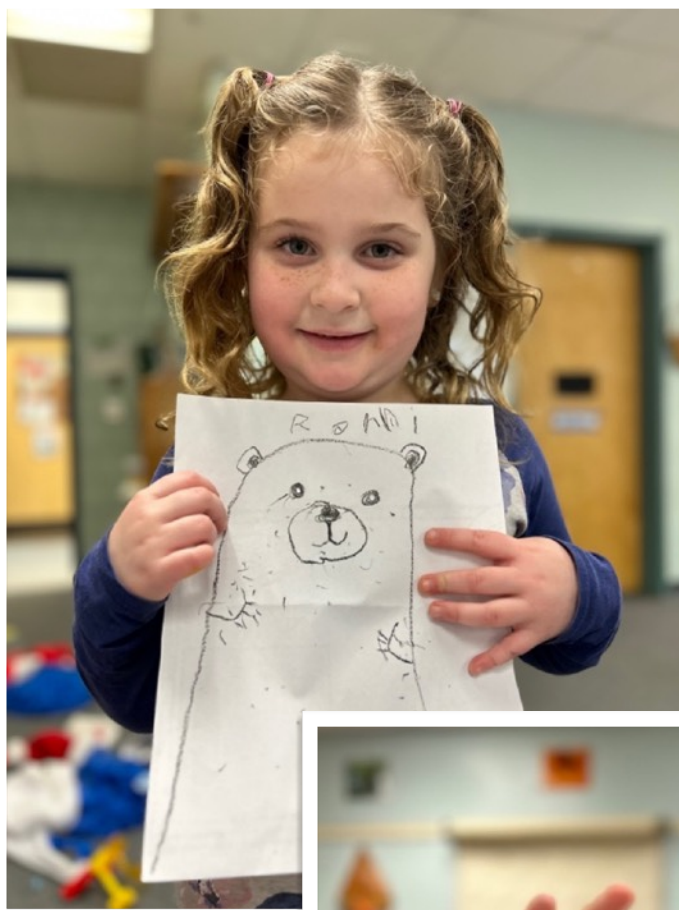
Fourth Grade
