- 2 x 10 x 8 boards to make raised beds (any number would help - we need 25 in all)
- landscaping cloth
- bags of soil
- two spades
- two rakes
- hoses
- garden trowels
- water sprinkler with a timer
- compost bin that rotates/turns
- 4-6" pots
- bark mulch
- a strong individual to remove a prickly bush from the front garden.
