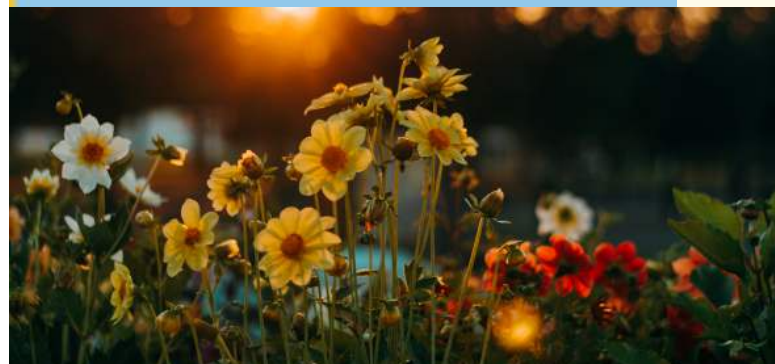

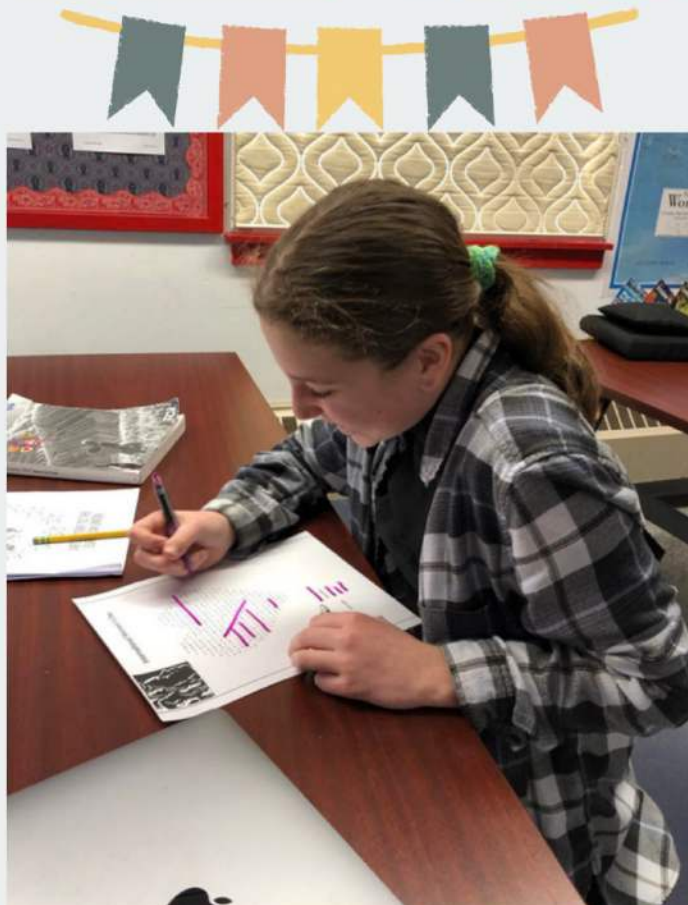

Civil Rights Team

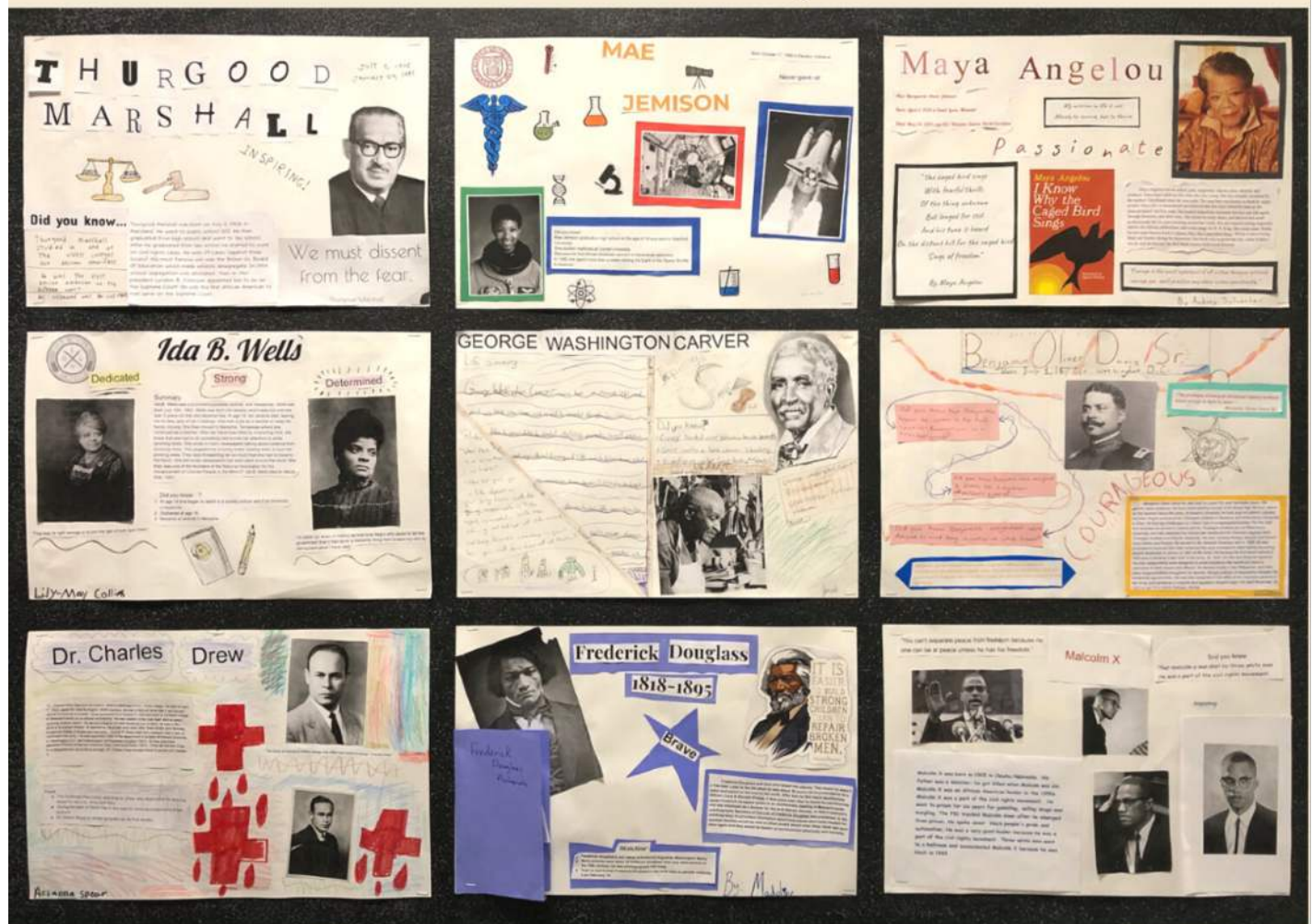


We meet regularly to work on projects that engage the HES community in thinking and talking about these civil rights issues:
