NUMBER and QUANTITY

Identifies numbers to 120 (50) (100) (120)

Counts and writes by 5s to 120 (50) (100) (120)

Counts and writes by 10s to 120

Counts and writes by 2s to 20

Recognizes place value to 1s and 10s place

Compares and orders numbers to 100 using symbols <, > and =
